

MAW Toys For Peace

Knitting patterns for Dolls' Peace Sweaters



Girl doll's sweater

Materials: small amounts of 4-ply yarn (about 15 g in all); needles size 12 (2.75 mm) and size 11 (3 mm) 2 small press studs

Tension: 7.5 sts to 1 inch (30 sts to 10 cm.) over st-st on size 11 needles.

Motifs on front of sweaters: the instructions are given for knitting these by the intarsia method; but if preferred they may be embroidered on afterwards using Swiss darning

BACK With size 12 needles cast on 22 sts and work 4 rows k1 p1 rib.

Change to size 11 needles and cont in st-st, starting with a k row, inc 1 st at centre of first row to give 23 sts.

(NB for Rainbow sweater, work rib and 2 rows st-st in Red, then 5 rows Orange, 6 rows each Yellow, Green, Blue, Indigo, and 5 rows Violet.)

After 24 rows st-st **divide for back opening:** k 12, turn, cast on 1 st for overlap and work 11 more rows st-st on these 13 sts, keeping the edge st in garter st (i.e.k every row). Cast off.

Rejoin yarn to inner edge of rem 11 sts, cast on 2 sts for under-border, and work 12 rows st-st on these 13 sts, keeping 1 edge st in garter st. Cast off.

FRONT With size 12 needles cast on 22 sts and work 4 rows k1 p1 rib.

Change to size 11 needles and cont in st-st, starting with a k row, inc 1 st at centre of first row to give 23 sts.

(NB For "No war" sweater only, inc 2 sts evenly across first row to give 24 sts). Follow pattern from chart until 33 rows st-st have been worked.

Shape neck: p9, turn; k2tog k7, turn, p6, p2tog, turn, cast off rem 7 sts.

Slip next 5 sts **(NB for "No war" sweater next 6 sts)** on to safety pin, rejoin yarn to rem 9 sts, p to end. Next row k7 k2tog. Next row p2tog p6. Cast off rem 7 sts.

SLEEVES (alike) With size 12 needles cast on 12 sts and work 4 rows k1 p1 rib.

Change to size 11 needles and cont in st-st, starting with a k row, inc 1 st at centre of first row to give 13 sts.

Then inc 1 st at each end of foll 2nd and 3 foll 5th rows (18 rows st-st worked, 21 sts). Work 4 rows straight.

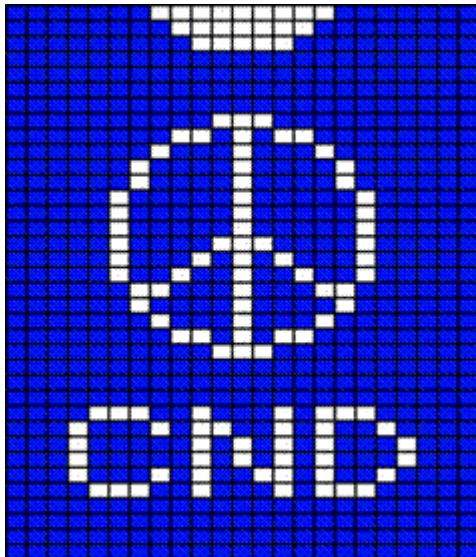
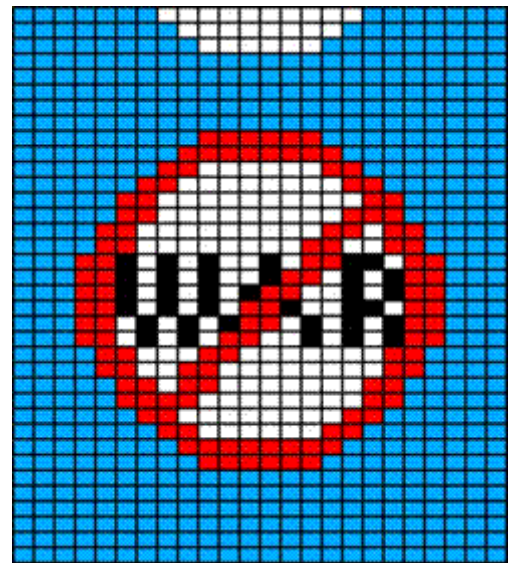
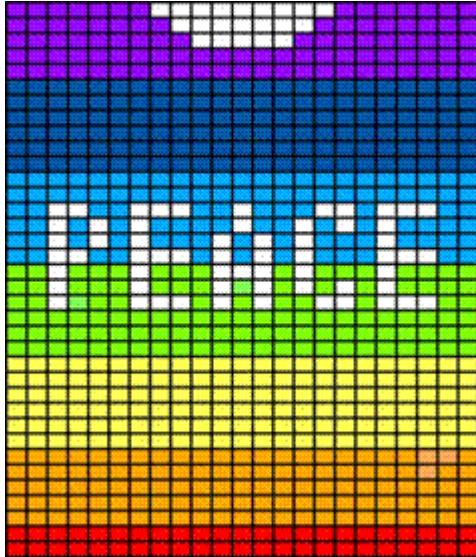
Cast off. **(NB For rainbow sweater, work rib and 2 rows st-st in Red, then 5 rows in each of Orange, Yellow, Green and Blue.)**

NECKBAND Join shoulder seams. With size 12 needles pick up and knit 6 sts from left back neck, 5 from left front neck, 5 (or 6) from safety pin, 5 from right front neck, and 6 from right back neck. (27 sts, or 28 for "No war" sweater). Work 1 row k1 p1 rib, Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP Sew on sleeves; join side and sleeve seams. Catch down under-border with a couple of stitches on wrong side of work. Attach 2 press studs, 1 at back neckband, one half way down back opening.

Boy doll's sweater

Materials: small amounts of 4-ply yarn (about 20 g in all); needles size 12 (2.75 mm) and size 10 (3.25 mm) 2 small press studs

Tension: 7 sts to 1 inch (28 sts to 10 cm.) over st-st on size 10 needles.

Motifs on front of sweaters: the instructions are given for knitting these by the intarsia method; but if preferred they may be embroidered on afterwards using Swiss darning

BACK With size 12 needles cast on 28 sts and work 5 rows k1 p1 rib.

Change to size 10 needles and cont in st-st, starting with a k row. (NB for **Rainbow sweater, work rib and 2 rows st-st in Red, then 6 rows each Orange, Yellow, Green, 7 rows Blue, 6 rows Indigo, and 7 rows Violet.**)

After 28 rows st-st **divide for back opening:** k 14, turn, cast on 1 st for overlap and work 11 more rows st-st on these 15 sts, keeping the edge st in garter st (i.e.k every row). Cast off.

Rejoin yarn to inner edge of rem 14 sts, cast on 2 sts for under-border, and work 12 rows st-st on these 16 sts, keeping 1 edge st in garter st. Cast off.

FRONT With size 12 needles cast on 28 sts and work 5 rows k1 p1 rib.

Change to size 10 needles and cont in st-st, starting with a k row. Follow pattern from chart until 33 rows st-st have been worked.

Shape neck: p12, turn; k2tog k10, turn, p9, p2 tog, turn, k2 tog k8. Work 3 more rows on rem 9 sts. Cast off.

Slip next 4 sts on to safety pin, rejoin yarn to rem 12 sts, p to end. Next row k10 k2tog. Next row p2 tog p9.

Next row k8 k2 tog. Work 3 more rows on rem 9 sts. Cast off.

SLEEVES (alike) With size 12 needles cast on 18 sts and work 5 rows k1 p1 rib.

Change to size 10 needles and cont in st-st, starting with a k row, inc 1 st at centre of first row to give 19 sts.

Then inc 1 st at each end of foll 3rd and 3 foll 6th rows (22 rows st-st worked, 27 sts). Work 5 rows straight.

Cast off. (NB For rainbow sweater, work rib and 3 rows st-st in Red, then 6 rows in each of Orange, Yellow, Green and Blue.)

NECKBAND Join shoulder seams. With size 12 needles pick up and knit 7 sts from left back neck, 8 from left front neck, 4 from safety pin, 8 from right front neck, and 6 from right back neck. (33 sts). Work 1 row k1 p1 rib, Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP Sew on sleeves; join side and sleeve seams. Catch down under-border on wrong side of work. Attach 2 press studs, 1 at back neckband, one half way down back opening.
