Essay and photography competitions

Terms and conditions:

- Entrants must be no older than 25 years of age
- No one who is a member of the executive committee of the Movement for the Abolition of War or of one or more of its sub-committees, nor anyone related to them, may enter
- Entries must be submitted by email to info@abolishwar.org.uk
- Entries must be submitted by midnight on Thursday 30 April 2015
- Entries must include name, age, email address, postal address, telephone number and a statement confirming that the entry is your own, original work
- Proof of age may be required
- A sufficient standard is needed for prizes to be awarded
- The decisions of the judges in each competition will be final
- The winner of each competition will receive a prize of £100
- Winners and two runners-up in each competition will receive one year's free membership of the Movement for the Abolition of War
- Winners and runners-up will be notified by email by midday on Friday 15th May 2015
- Winning entries will be published with permission and acknowledgements on the Movement for the Abolition of War website and youth blog

Essay competition guidelines:

- Theme: what can be done to abolish war?
- Entries will be judged on originality, creativity and critical thinking, and must follow logical reasoning
- 1500 words maximum

Movement for the Abolition of War

Photo competition guidelines:

- Theme: what does peace mean to you?
- Entries will be judged on creativity and clarity of message
- Include with your entry a 50-word statement linking your photo to the theme
- Any method to capture the photo may be used
- Image to be uploaded in JPEG/JPG
- Image size to be no larger than 2GB
- Use *We Transfer* if the image file is too large for an email, using your name as the file name
