Description of the organisation:

Mayors for Peace was formed in 1982 after the mayors of Hiroshima and Nagasaki appeared at the 2<sup>nd</sup> UN Special Session on Disarmament and called for cities to come together in solidarity for peace and, specifically, the abolition of nuclear weapons. Today, Mayors for Peace is an integral, leading force in a growing city diplomacy movement seeking to ensure that the voice and role of cities is recognized by national governments. In November 2003, when Mayors for Peace launched the 2020 Vision Campaign we had 562 members. Since then we have grown in size dramatically. As of 1 July 2010, our membership stood at 4,037 cities in 144 countries and regions.
